Missing Pieces of the Puzzle

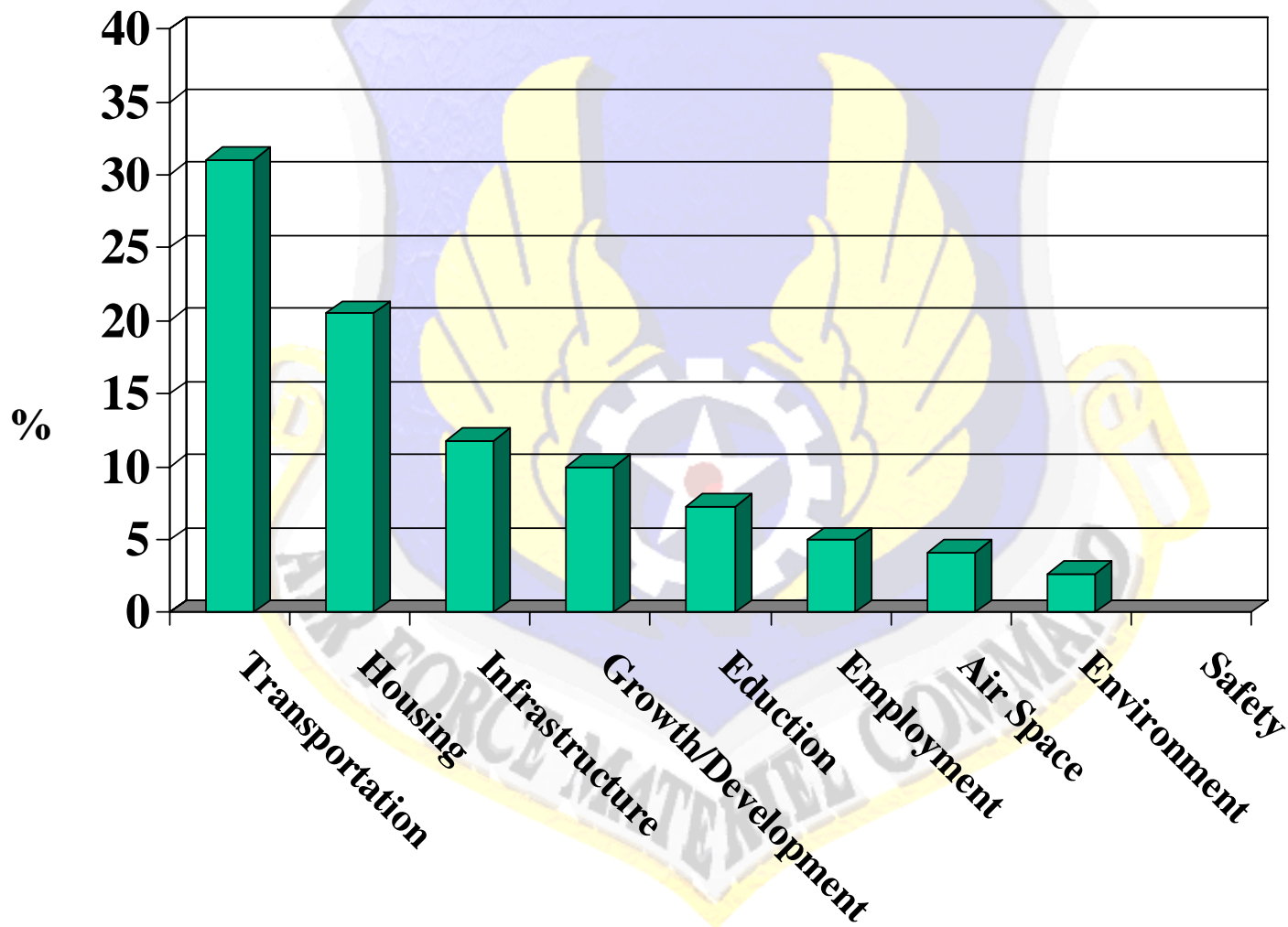
