Expanding Community Dialogue

- ✓ Hosted the 4th Annual **TeCMEN Industry Day** featuring an expo hall, keynote presentation, industry panels and educational workshops.
- ✓ Hosted Roundtable breakfast "The U.S. Economy: Where Do We Go From Here?" featuring Adrienne Slack, US Federal Reserve Bank.
- Assisted the Okaloosa County Board of County Commissioners with efforts to recognize the value of the local manufacturing sector through the acknowledgement of "Manufacturing Appreciation Month" in October 2021.
- ✓ Presented three free professional development webinars "Building a Winning Career in a Technical Profession", "Using Branding & Technology to Reach Customers & Attract Talent" and "Creative Employee Retention in a Competitive Environment".

Enhancing Competitiveness

- ✓ Worked with the Destin Area Chamber of Commerce and the Destin Charter Boat Association to develop and launch a four session "Business Best Practices Seminar Series" for the Destin Charter Fishing Fleet.
- ✓ Aided the Okaloosa County Board of County Commissioners with development strategies for the **588 acres of prime industrial land** that the County owns within **Shoal River Ranch Gigasite**. Worked with Barge Design Group to develop site concept renderings.

Supporting Workforce and Talent Development

- Expanded the Talent Attraction Portal located on One Okaloosa EDC's website. Added information on private / parochial school options and developed a new Preferred Provider Directory spotlighting local service providers within 10 specific sectors.
- ✓ Partnered with the HSU Educational Foundation, the Okaloosa County School District and Rocky Bayou Christian School to host **22 area high school students** for interface with manufacturing / technology sector employers at the 4th Annual TeCMEN Industry Day.
- ✓ As a result of the BEST 2020-2021 existing industry survey initiative, hosted a Capstone workforce development breakfast designed to foster conversation and collaboration between industry representatives and workforce development / education partners.

Strengthening the Military Mission

- ✓ Continued **Federal legislative outreach** in support of extending the moratorium on oil drilling in the eastern Gulf of Mexico.
- ✓ Through One Okaloosa EDC's **Defense Support Initiatives (DSI)**, developed a comprehensive **legislative position paper** speaking to key Federal funding and policy priorities for local military installations and missions.
- ✓ In support of the FY 2022 NDAA, conducted virtual issues briefings with representatives from the offices of Congressman Gaetz, Congressman Dunn, Congressman Murphy, Congressman Diaz-Balart, Congressman Franklin, Senator Rubio and Senator Scott.
- ✓ Utilized One Okaloosa EDC's **Tri-County Community Partnership Initiative (TCPI)** to tackle key community challenges faced by installations. Stood up Purple Star Schools TCPI Task Force and championed passage of legislation creating a new statewide program.
- ✓ Kicked off a community-wide TCPI "Ideas Refresh" process led by the **Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Energy, Installations and the Environment (SAF/IE).**

Facilitating New Jobs and Investment

- ✓ Continued **BEST (Business Expansion Support Team)** initiative, interviewing **21** local businesses with operations in the manufacturing, defense and technology sectors. Published a summary report of aggregated findings and distributed to city / county elected leaders.
- ✓ Initiated and assisted **42** new investment projects with projected capital investment of over **\$10 billion** and the creation of approximately **13,851** new jobs. Coordinated **15 local site visits** with site consultants and decision makers.
- ✓ Supported two **Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption** (EDATE) incentive applications for Projects Dunk and Blue Waves.
- ✓ Supported a successful UWF Industry Resilience & Diversification Fund (IRDF) grant application for **US Meltblown** in Fort Walton Beach and a successful USDA Meat and Poultry Inspection Readiness Grant (MPIRG) for **Big Creek Farms** in Laurel Hill.
- Recruited **Dunkin'** franchisee **Purple Square Management** to invest **\$4.5 million** in the construction of a 24,500 SF state-of-the-art commercial bakery and distribution facility that will employ **60** individuals in the Okaloosa Industrial Air Park.
